Fifth Sunday of Easter, May 10, 2020**



Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ:

In Saint John's Gospel this weekend, the Fifth Sunday of Easter, (14:1-12), the Blessed Trinity is revealed to the disciples. Jesus said: "I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me. If you know me, then you will also know my Father."

This weekend, I want you to know that in addition to our parishes and the many vital ministries of the Diocese of Rockville Centre, the COVID-19 pandemic is greatly testing Catholic education and the Tomorrow's Hope Foundation.
